ANNOUNCEMENT

The trombone that Mr. McKnight will be performing on tonight was discovered in Calvary's band closet just a little over one month ago. It is a Frank Holton "Special" trombone, manufactured in 1916. The trombone's case, bell, slide, and mouthpiece are all original and in excellent shape, rare for an instrument of this age.

Also original and unique are the trombone's two tuning slides. Before the standardization of A440 tuning, instrumentalists needed two tuning slides to adjust the tuning to the band or orchestra the player was performing with.

The instrument was donated to Calvary Moravian in December of 1969 by Hugh Latham Ross. Mr. Ross was born on December 2, 1894 and died on November 11, 1987. He married Sadie Transou, aunt of Jane Sofley. He served the United States during WWI; his name is on a plaque in Calvary's narthex honoring those that served. Mr. Ross was a CPA and retired from AM Pullen Company. After joining the Moravian church, Mr. Ross used the trombone in the church band.

Tonight's performance is a rededication of this trombone to Calvary Moravian's music ministry.
