## YOUTH, COLLEGE AGE, AND YOUNG ADULT MINISTRIES AT CALVARY

This season we are working to re-imagine and restructure our Youth ministries as well as working diligently with some friends from the Province to provide opportunities for our College Age and Young Adult members. Realizing that sustainable programming for all these age brackets sometimes proves difficult given how busy and scheduled they often are at this time in their lives, we still see a need and desire to continue educational, outreach, and fun opportunities for these students and young adults.

***Our Youth programming*** will be divided into two groups: Middle High and Senior High and will be led by our Youth Ministries Leadership Team comprised of Bill and Linda Seippel, Hanna Jackson, Melanie Nance, Mike Sigmon, and Cathy Smith. Each week these leaders will shepherd our youth (and any college age kids that are still in the Winston-Salem area!) in study, fellowship, outreach, and fun activities.

Also, we are planning some separate ***College Age activities*** throughout the school year for those students who are attending school in our area as well as times when those who are away for school will be home and can all be together. We will be combining a few of those activities with other college age kids from around the Province – the more the merrier!

Additionally, for our ***Young Adults (ages 18-35-ish)***, Calvary is hosting a weekly ***YAM Chat*** within our ***Calvary@The Table*** fall programming. Young Adults from around our province will gather at Calvary between 5:00-6:00 p.m. for dinner (if they so choose), and then head over to Footnote Café (across from Calvary) for a study and conversation with the Reverend Chaz Snider (Ardmore Moravian) who will facilitate the group from 6:00-7:00 p.m. Stay tuned for more information!
