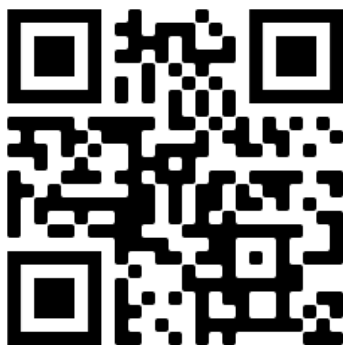
The above procedure does not apply to the member prayer list that is also in the bulletin each week. That list is maintained by staff who are more aware of the needs of members within the Calvary community.

Kindly submit all recipes no later than **April 18.**

To Submit Recipes Online:

- Go to www.tybensave.com and click 'Login.'
- Enter the user name: calvarymoravian
- Enter the password: pickle041 and click 'Submit.'
- Enter your name and click 'Continue.'
- Click 'Add Recipes' to begin adding your recipes.
- Click 'Preview' to see how it'll look, and then be sure to click 'Save.'

Recipe Writing Tips:

- When adding recipes online, review 'Tips' provided on the website.
- Use standard abbreviations (tsp., Tbsp., pkg., lb., oz., etc.).
- Only enter 1 ingredient per line (hit "return/enter" to create a new line).
- List ingredients in order of use in the ingredients list and directions.
- Include container sizes, e.g., (16-oz.) pkg., (24-oz.) can.

- Use names of ingredients in the directions, e.g., “Combine flour and sugar.” DO NOT use statements like, “Combine first three ingredients” as columns may shift and cause confusion.
- Include temps as well as cooking and/or chilling times, etc..
- There is no designated place for additional comments about the recipe (history, nutritional data, suggested uses, etc.), so any info of that nature should either be left out or added to the directions.

Easter Grave-Cleaning and Flowering

Once again this year the youth and children will be offering their services to help any members, families, or friends of our congregation in the Easter tradition of cleaning graves in God’s Acre. We plan to clean graves on Good Friday, April 2, just as we have in years past. We are grateful again to Nick Stone who has secured flower availability, but this year we will have only one flower option:

6 inch potted Red Geranium (\$20 per plant)

Each pot will be wrapped with paper and a bow, and if desired, placed upon the grave requested or you may pick them up Good Friday morning at Calvary. GOOD FRIDAY, APRIL 2, 7 PM

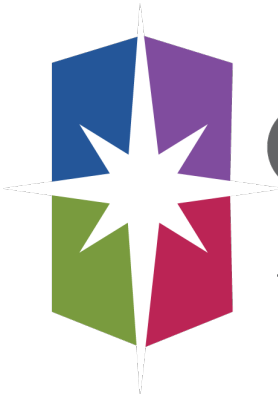
Our Good Friday Lovefeast will be live-streamed only. You are encouraged to participate in the Lovefeast at home as we remember Christ's atoning death for our salvation.
