#### JOINT BOARD

At its March meeting the Joint Board received a cost-saving communications proposal from Jacob Patrick, Office & Communications Manager, which is detailed on pg. 4.

#### **ELDERS**

At the March meeting, the Elders received an update on HD live-streaming. The hope is to install the new cameras sometime after Easter.

They approved the appointment of Susie McCollum and Elaine Palmore as co-chairs of the Discipleship Committee and discussed the possibility of entering into a long-term contract with Salem Presbyterian.

#### TRUSTEES (FROM SPENCER BULLINS)

The Trustees discussed the following. They voted to approve the purchase of new high definition streaming cameras to improve the quality of our video. They also discussed the recent electrical work to add circuits and outlets in the streaming room to locate one of the copier machines there.

The Trustees reviewed the status of Wells Fargo increasing the credit line of our church credit card. New credit limits should be in place soon.

### COMMUNICATIONS UPDATE

On March 15, the Joint Board voted to enact some new strategies for the publications Calvary produces. Starting this summer, the Calvary Connection will move to a quarterly system with issues published August, November, February, and May. This will enable the staff to put out a more robust newsletter with articles topical to the liturgical season on the whole.

Many of the monthly segments of the newsletter will be moved to our weekly email, especially the first-of-the-month edition. This includes board and financial updates. 
